





Did you know that the water you use today is the same water the dinosaurs were drinking millions of years ago? There is only so much water on planet Earth. It gets recycled through the water cycle.


Water evaporates into the sky and forms clouds. It returns as rain, snow, and other forms of precipitation. On the ground, water becomes runoff that flows over and through the ground to get back to large bodies of water.




When rain hits the ground where does it go?

If you are on a road, the water needs to go somewhere.




Stormwater systems catch the water in drains and take it through a series of pipes to a local waterway.

Follow the maze to help the water reach the waterway.




There are lots of things you can do to keep our water clean. Don't pour anything down the storm drains. They are just for rain.
